# Cutthorpe primary School Uniform Policy

## (#223)

### **Introduction**

At Cutthorpe Primary School, we take pride in our school uniform and believe it plays a crucial role in fostering a positive and focused learning environment. Our uniform policy aims to instil a sense of identity, unity, and pride among our students while ensuring a neat and respectful appearance. This policy encompasses both the daily school uniform and the Physical Education (PE) attire. We kindly request the full cooperation of all students and their parents/guardians in adhering to these guidelines.

### **1. Daily School Uniform**

#### **1.1. Neat Appearance**

- Students are expected to maintain a neat and tidy appearance. This includes well-groomed hair (long hair should be tied up), the correct school shoes, and all clothing items in good condition.

#### **1.2. Uniform Labelling**

- **All** clothing items, especially uniforms, should be clearly labelled with the student's name to prevent loss and confusion.

#### **1.3. Tucked-in Shirts**

- Students are required to tuck in their shirts while wearing the school uniform.

#### **1.4. School Uniform Components**

- The daily school uniform includes:
  - A white shirt or blouse with the option of a school logo.
  - Grey trousers/shorts, skirt, or pinafore & red/white gingham summer dress.
  - Black shoes (not trainers).

#### **1.5. Optional Outerwear**

- Students should bring a sensible, waterproof, outdoor coat, clearly labelled.

#### **1.7. Jewellery**

- **No** jewellery is to be worn except a wrist watch and no more than one pair of stud earrings. Earrings should be taped, during PE for the first 6 weeks after piercing – tape must be provided by the pupil. Wrist watches must be removed during PE.

## **2. Physical Education (PE) Uniform**

### **2.1. PE Uniform Components**

- The PE uniform consists of:
  - A uniform purple t-shirt with the school logo.
  - A uniform grey hoodie with the school logo.
  - Plain black or navy sports shorts and/or tracksuit bottoms. Girls may wear plain black leggings if preferred.
  - Appropriate sports shoes suitable for indoor and outdoor physical activities.

### **2.2. Hair**

- Hair must be tied back off the face during PE activities.

### **2.3. Footwear**

- Pupils are not permitted to wear Converse/high tops as part of their PE uniform. Proper sports shoes should be worn for PE activities.

### **2.4. Importance of the PE Uniform**

- The PE uniform is a symbol of teamwork, sportsmanship, and school spirit. It is essential for participation in physical education classes.

## **3. Compliance and Enforcement**

- It is crucial that all students adhere to these uniform guidelines. Teachers and staff members will monitor uniform compliance.

## **4. Assistance and Concerns**

- Parents and guardians who have concerns or require assistance with school uniforms are encouraged to contact the school office. We are here to help ensure that all students have the opportunity to thrive.
